Introduction

Thank you for purchasing MITSUBISHI Integrated FA Software, MELSOFT MX series.

This document explains how to install and uninstall the product. Please read carefully before installing the product to your personal computer.

Installation

Install the product to the personal computer.

Confirm before installation

- · Log on to the personal computer as a user having the "Administrator" (computer administration) privilege.
- Close all the applications running under Microsoft[®] Windows[®] Operating System before installation. If the product is installed while other applications are running, it may not operate normally.
- 1. Insert the CD-ROM to the CD-ROM drive. Double click the "SETUP.EXE" file on the CD-ROM.
- 2. Following the on-screen instructions, select or enter the necessary information.

Point

- Serial number is written on the "License certificate" included with the product. Enter the 12-digit number divided into 3 and 9 digits.
- For details of installation, refer to the manual on the CD-ROM included with the product.
- When installing MELSOFT to a Windows Vista[®], Windows[®] 7, Windows[®] 8 and Windows[®] 8.1 based personal computer, read the technical bulletin FA-A-0008, FA-A-0091, and FA-A-0153 respectively.



*1: Enter a serial number written on the "License certificate" with dividing 12-digit number into 3 and 9 digits.
