■ Introduction

Thank you for purchasing MITSUBISHI Integrated FA Software, MELSOFT series.

This document explains how to install and uninstall GT Works3 (SW1DND-GTWK3-E□). Please read carefully before installing the product to your personal computer.

Installation

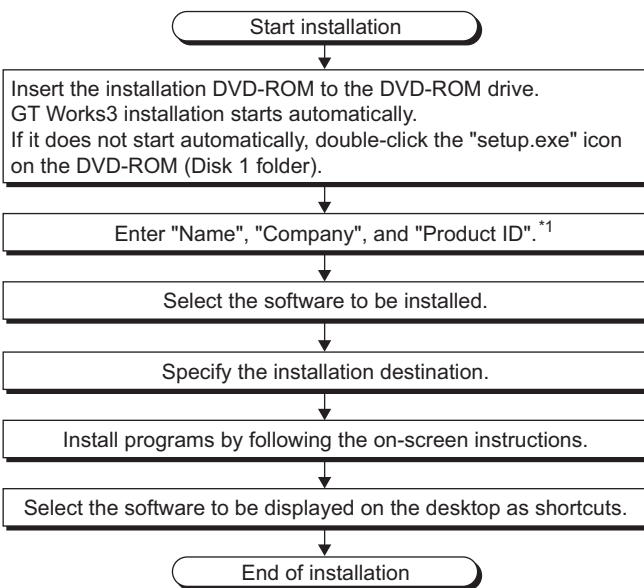
Install GT Works3 to the personal computer.

■ Check before installation

- Log on to the personal computer as a user having the "Administrator" (computer administration) privilege.
- Close all the softwares running under Microsoft® Windows® Operating System before installation. If the product is installed while other softwares are running, it may not operate normally.

■ Batch installation

Install multiple software in a batch.



*1: Product ID is written on the "License certificate" included with the product. Enter the 12-digit number divided into 3 and 9 digits.

Double-click the "setup.exe" icon in each folder to install the software. For the software where the setup.exe is not included, copy the entire folder and then run it.

- The newer version software may be downloaded from MITSUBISHI ELECTRIC FA Global Website. In order to download the newer version software, membership registration of MITSUBISHI ELECTRIC FA Global Website is required.
- After installation, please do not save the data in the following folder.
