

wire indicates the temperature value of approximately 0.12°C higher than that of the wire resistor (10 Ω). Temperature value should be used in consideration of this point.

If the compensating lead wire is very long, the wire may be easily affected by noise. etc. It is, therefore, recommended that the length of the compensating lead wire should be 100 m (328' 1") or less.
