

## Installation Instructions

### Introduction

Thank you for purchasing MITSUBISHI Integrated FA Software, MELSOFT series.

This document explains how to install and uninstall GX Configurator2-DN (SW1DNC-GXC2DN-E□). Please read carefully before installing the product to your personal computer.

## Installation

Install GX Configurator2-DN to the personal computer.

### Confirm before installation

- GX Configurator2-DN is an add-in software product for GX Works2. Install the product to the personal computer where GX Works2 Version 1.03D or later is installed.
- Log on to the personal computer as a user having the "Administrator" (computer administration) privilege.
- Close all the applications running under Microsoft® Windows® Operating System before installation. If the product is installed while other applications are running, it may not operate normally.

1. Insert the CD-ROM to the CD-ROM drive.  
Double click the "Setup.exe" file on the CD-ROM.
2. Following the on-screen instructions, select or enter the necessary information.
