Method of installing the MELSOFT Series

Thank you for choosing the Mitsubishi integrated FA Software MELSOFT Series. In order to use this product, install the component to the personal computer according to the following procedure.

[Procedures for Installing and Uninstalling]

- Make sure to close all running applications before installation. Installation under running another application may cause abnormal operation of the product.
- When installing multiple products, install the GX Developer first.
- When using any of the following operating systems, log on as a user who has the administrator attributes. Windows[®] 8^{*1}, Windows[®] 7^{*2}, Windows Vista[®] *³, Windows[®] XP^{*4}, Microsoft[®] Windows[®] 2000 Professional Operating System, Microsoft[®] Windows NT[®] Workstation Operating System Version 4.0
